Costa Victoria – Singapore, Thailand, Malaysia

- Our adventurous excursion begins with a **short tour** where we will see the island's **rubber plantations**, local dwellings and the mosques (tour of the exterior).
- Once we arrive at **Safari Island**, a site which uniquely fuses the love for ecology with adventure, we will have the opportunity to sample the thrill of climbing **on elephant-back** and the chance to admire the evolution of the hulking great brutes whilst watching an entertaining show.
- If desired, it is also possible **to feed** the pachyderm (fruit can be purchased on-site).
- After the show, we will head to one of the island's most-loved temples, **Wat Chaiyathararam** or Wat Chalong, a monastery near to the city of Phuket. This sanctuary is also known as **Wat Luang Pho Cham**, to honour the monk, who in 1876, during the reign of Rama V, helped put down the rebellion led by Chinese labourers, known as **Angyeee**.
- The next stop on our tour will lead us to the site where **cashews** or cashew nuts, one of the island's most important production elements, are produced. During our visit, we will see all stages from **harvesting to the end product**, and then we will taste the end result in a much-welcomed **tasting** session.
- It would be a real shame not to purchase this delicious product to take home with you.
- The last leg of our tour provides time to purchase souvenirs, local products, handicrafts, pearls and rocks.
- Casual clothing that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- You have to climb a flight of steps to reach Wat Chaiyathararam.
- This excursion involves standing and walking for a total of one and a half hours.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- During the visit to Island Safari, as in the rest of the tour, guests may be split into small groups.

- Not far from the Buddhist temple, we will find **Phuket Orchid Garden & Thai Village**; after digesting the interesting visit to the splendid **orchid nursery**, we will head to Thai Village and see a **traditional folklore show**, which presents local traditions and customs.
- Lastly, before returning to the ship, it is possible to spend some time in the **local shops** to buy souvenirs, handicrafts, local products, pearls and rocks.
- Clothing that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.
- You must remove footwear and wear socks to enter the Temple. Legs and shoulders must be covered.

The island of Phuket has a rich religious heritage characterised by extremely varied temples and sanctuaries which create a fascinating architectural contrast which must be discovered

- Our excursion begins at the **temple of Jui Tui**, a typically Chinese temple, the architectural style of which is notably different from the Thai style, which constantly attracts believers, eager to have their future read.
- We will then move onto the Buddhist temple of **Wat Phra Thong** or Wat Phra Phud, where we can admire the famous half-buried golden Buddha statue.
- Continuing along the magical road along the island's western coastline, we pass the amazing beaches of Kamala, Patong, Kata and Karon\*\* to arrive at the island's southern high point.
- From **Promthep Cape** it is possible to take some photos and take in the splendid views of the surrounding islands, the marvellous beach of **Nai Harn** and the windmills.
- Our final visit takes us to **Wat Chalong**, Phuket's most famous temple, which according to the Thai people, protects the island from evil. Inside, there are bronze depictions of the three famous monks, who are greatly respected by the inhabitants of Phuket: Luang Por Chaem, Luang Por Kleam and Luang Por Chuang.
- Once lunch time arrives, we will head to a **Thai restaurant** where we can sample exquisite, typical, local dishes.
- Now that we are full, we can do some **shopping** and purchase local handicrafts, pewter items, wood sculptures, Thai silk, pearls and rocks.
- There is limited availability of English-language guides.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- Comfortable shoes are recommended.

- The beauty of **Koh Tapu (Nail Island)**, next to the Island of James Bond, will literally leave us speechless. Some advertising campaigns for famous perfumes were staged here.
- We will then head to **Koh Panyee**, where we will visit an old **fisherman's village** which dates back 150 years. Here, it is possible to speak to local people, visit the island's **mosque** with its striking minaret and stroll around amongst the "stalls and shops" within this small community, entirely supported by **piles**.
- Once we leave the island, we will head onto the **island of Rang Yai**, where a delicious **lunch** awaits.

- In the afternoon we will have some free time to relax on the island's splendid **beach** and cool off swimming in the crystal-clear waters.
- Finally, we will return to our speed boat and go back to the Royal Phuket Marina where the coaches awaits to take us back to the ship.

You will marvel at the painstaking restoration of this house and its breathtaking antique furniture and woodwork. Please Note: The order of the itinerary may vary. **GEORGETOWN AND SUBURBS**


**Description**

You will travel past the main commercial district into the outskirts of Georgetown, passing the official residence of Penang's governor. On your way to the Botanical Gardens you will drive along roads lined with huge rain trees and flanked by handsome suburban houses and some of the beautiful colonial homes built during the period of British rule. You will stop at the Penang Botanical Gardens, also know as the Waterfall Gardens, for a pleasant stroll. The gardens were laid out by the British in 1884, and offer an extensive display of native and hybrid orchids, cacti, a wide variety of ferns, bamboo plants, flowering trees and shrubs. They are inhabited by long-tailed macaques, which will add some excitement to your visit. Visit the Thai Buddhist Temple, which houses the 4th largest Reclining Buddha in the world. You will then stop at the Baba Nyonya Museum, also known as the Pinang Peranakan Mansion or the Chung Keng Kwee Museum. This was formally a private home belonging to the Chinese head of the Hai San secret society. The building - an impressive Straits Eclectic-style mansion - is an architectural marvel. The late-Victorian influence is particularly clear in the profuse use of decorative cast iron, and this is one of the few buildings in Penang whose cast iron fixtures

survived the Japanese occupation intact. You will marvel at the painstaking restoration of this house and its breathtaking antique furniture and woodwork. A Baba guide well versed in Baba Nyonya culture and Chinese Feng Shui will explain in detail what each carving, design, and painting depicts. This mansion is a storehouse of antiques. A life-size statue of Chung Keng Kwee himself, attired in his Mandarin's robe and a Manchu Mandarin cap, is displayed in his family temple next to the house. Before returning to the port, visit the bustling waterfront, where the houses on stilts form a water village built by the early Chinese immigrants, hinting at Penang's past.

**ROUND THE ISLAND**

**Description**

From the bustle of Georgetown's waterfront to the countryside of Penang, this tour will allow you the chance to circle the island and admire some of its most interesting sights. Firstly visit the esteemed Khoo Kongsi where the walls, pillars and roof are richly decorated with intricate carvings bearing the marks of master craftsmen from China and the beams are made from wood of the finest quality. The temple was rebuilt in 1920 after it was gutted by fire. Some believe the fire was brought about because of the resemblance of the building to the Emperor's Palace in China. From here you will enjoy a leisurely drive towards the northern tip of Penang, passing beautiful coves and the bays of Batu Ferringhi with a stop at a local batik workshop, where you will be shown the intricate and timeless art of decorating fabric with wax and dyes. Scents of clove and nutmeg will follow as you drive through the hills, where you will stop at a local fruit and spice stall for a closer look at the fresh species and local fruits. Before going back to the ship, you will have the chance to see the other side of Penang, the quiet Malay villages, known as Kampung. These are scattered all over the island, giving you a true taste of the local life.

The most beautiful Chinese Clan House to be built outside China. The intricate wood and granite living together with 24 stone carved classic example of

filial piety makes this place a must for visitor to Penang.. On your return journey, we will visit one of the Local Product Shop.

- Our fascinating tour upon the discovery of Singapore begins with a visit to the **orchid national garden**, nestled within the spectacular **botanical gardens of Singapore**. The park's **74 hectares**, which include a complete tropical forest and frangipani, rose, fern gardens and desert plants (to quote just a few), were recently awarded **UNESCO World Heritage Site** status, the first tropical garden in the world to boast this title.
- The area dedicated to the orchids houses **the largest collection of tropical orchids** in Asia, with more than 2,000 hybrid varieties and 1,000 orchid species.

- Our tour continues onto Singapore's **ethnic areas** beginning with **Little India**, a lively and colourful area characterised by small stores, the aroma of spices and music. We will then continue onto **Arab Street**, a Muslim area specialising in Indonesian batik, silk, sarongs and various blouses; and then **Chinatown**, Singapore's cultural centre, which, with its temples, decorated balconies and lively roads offers insight on life in times past.
- Afterwards we will head to the colonial district, where we will board a **boat** to take us from Clarke Quay to **Merlion Park**. We will stop briefly to take some photos of the statue of **Merlion**, the mythological figure with a lion's head and mermaid's body which is now the symbol of the city, and admire the fascinating skyline of the **Central Business District**.
- Once lunch time arrives, we will head to **Blue Ginger**, a restaurant within a former shop which offers authentic **peranakan cuisine**, not to be missed whilst out in Singapore.
- With full stomachs and restored, we will continue on our tour and head to the **Singapore National Museum**: this cultural and architectural reference point in Singapore, which initiated its activity in 1887, is the nation's oldest museum whilst being forward thinking. Within the splendid architecture, the so-called "**10 national treasures**" are kept, which date back from the 14th century to the fifties, selected by the National Museum based upon their rarity, and more importantly, their incomparable relevancy in the context of Singapore's socio-cultural history.
- Our tour comes to an end with a stop at **Mount Faber**, where we can enjoy a unique view of the island of Sentosa and the skyline of Singapore; a view to be immortalised in photographic scenes.
